CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CONFEDERATED TRIBES OF THE GRAND RONDE COMMUNITY OF OREGON

GRAND RONDE OR 97347

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-29131. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: COSPER CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 0.7 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: OCTOBER 9, 1963

The point of diversion is located as follows:

6 S	7 W	WM	8	NE NW	6	24 FEET SOUTH AND 1220 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point(s) of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 26, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 142, approving Transfer Application T-10569, supercedes Certificate 36796, State record of Water Right Certificates.
