The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. Provided further than in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, the totalizing flow meters, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each new point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:
