CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-10111. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL IN THE FORT ROCK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 5.4 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 6, 1983

The well is located as follows:

26 S	15 E	WM	33	NW NW	1320 FEET SOUTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 33

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

27 S	15 E	WM	4	SW NE	1800 FEET SOUTH AND 1120 FEET EAST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 33

Water use measurement conditions:

- a. The water user shall maintain the meters, or other suitable measuring devices as approved by the Director, in good working order at each point of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


b. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

c. The meters or measuring devices shall be properly maintained. Each meter shall be either within 50 feet of the well head with a clearly visible monument adjacent to the meter or a surveyed location shall be provided and a clearly visible monument adjacent to the meter shall be installed for each meter more than 50 feet from the well head.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 19, 2014, at Special Order Volume 92, Page 593, approving Transfer Application T-11525, and together with Certificate 89287, supercedes Certificate 66225, State record of Water Right Certificates.
