 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WESTSIDE IRRIGATION AND WATER DITCH CO.
 301 SE 6TH STREET
 ENTERPRISE OR 97828

confirms the right to use the waters of LOSTINE RIVER, a tributary of the WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 118.8 ACRES, DOMESTIC and LIVESTOCK use.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Pages 200, 201 & 202. The date of priority is MARCH 27, 1901.

Rate: 2.92 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), being 1.95 CFS for the period of May 1 through July 31, and 0.97 CFS for the period of August 1 through September 30

Limit/Duty: Annual Volume Limitation of 475.2 Acre Feet. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31 of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion at the Westside Ditch, described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, the totalizing flow meters, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 8, 2018, at Special Order Volume 107, Page 311, approving allocation of conserved water application CW-95, and together with Certificate 93536 and a portion of Certificate 93535, supersedes Certificate 81644, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
