 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of CANYON CREEK for IRRIGATION OF 3.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is MAY 1904.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.075 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

14 S	31 E	WM	25	NW SW	ORIGINAL (KOGER DITCH) - 2250 FEET NORTH AND 920 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 25
14 S	31 E	WM	25	SW NW	ADDITIONAL – 1470 FEET SOUTH AND 510 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 25

That the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30, measured at point of diversion.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

14 S	31 E	WM	25	SW NW	1.0

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 28, 1991, at Special Order Volume 45, Page 70, approving Transfer Application T-6410, and together with Certificate 65150, supercedes Certificate 25441, State record of Water Right Certificates.
