confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit R-11367. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: UNNAMED SPRINGS, A TRIBUTARY OF THE UMPQUA RIVER, IN FIVE RESERVOIRS, APPROPRIATED UNDER PERMIT 51211

PURPOSE OR USE: MULTI-PURPOSE USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 11.455 ACRE-FEET (AF) EACH YEAR; BEING 2.5 AF IN RESERVOIR A, 1.4 AF IN RESERVOIR B, 2.0 AF IN RESERVOIR C, 5.524 AF IN RESERVOIR D, AND 0.0307 AF IN RESERVOIR E

DATE OF PRIORITY: JUNE 14, 1990

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provisions of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.


By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 1, 2014, at Special Order Volume 92, Page 935, approving Transfer Application T-11577, supercedes Certificate 87403, State record of Water Right Certificates.
