CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-21652. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: SALT CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-24551, PERMIT R-1405, A TRIBUTARY OF SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 319.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 2.65 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.37 CFS FROM POD B

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 28, 1950

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit R-1405, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 26, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 779, approving Transfer Application T-7814, and together with Certificate 76181, supercedes Certificate 30029, State record of Water Right Certificates.
