CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRED KNAPE
RT 1 BOX 163
COVE, OR 97824

confirms the right to use the waters of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 211.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-28560. The date of priority is OCTOBER 30, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.41 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Lower Grande Ronde River is more than 300 cubic feet per second at USGS Gage. No. 3325 and more than 420 cubic feet per second at the Oregon-Washington border, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 41055, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 05 2019, approving Transfer Application T-12591.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
