CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HENRY J. BASSETT
HALFWAY, OR 97834

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST PINE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 11.1 ACRES, DOMESTIC, and STOCK USE for TRACT NO. 1 and IRRIGATION of 10.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC and STOCK USE for TRACT NO. 2.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 11, at Page 235. The dates of priority are 1898 for TRACT NO. 1 and 1885 for TRACT NO. 2.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre measured at the point of diversion, and a total limitation of one acre-foot per acre during July, and one acre-foot per acre during August, and one-half acre-foot per acre during September of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:


