CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 6 in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 122.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9348. The date of priority is APRIL 28, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.53 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.


Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 90486, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 18 2020, approving Transfer Application T-12515.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
