CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHAS. H. BROOKS AND THOS SEIGEL
RICHLAND, OREGON

Confirms the right to use the waters of Squaw Gulch, a tributary of Powder River for the purposes of supplemental irrigation.

This right was perfected under Permit S-2447. The date of priority is April 21, 1915. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.73 cubic feet per second, (together with the amount for which a right already exists for said lands) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the portion of Certificate 2750 NOT modified by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 51, Page 423 approving a partial cancellation. This certificate supersedes Certificate 2750.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
