CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

C.H. BROOKS  
RICHLAND, OREGON

Confirms the right to use the waters of Eagle Creek, a tributary of Powder River, for the purposes of irrigation of 32.2 acres of land.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at page 291. The date of priority is 1881 for 10.2 acres; July 12, 1900 for 22.0 acres.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes the portion of Certificate 4611 NOT modified by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 51, Page 423 approving a partial cancellation. This certificate supersedes Certificate 4611.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
