CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CLAUS P. SASS
RICHLAND, OREGON

Confirms the right to use the waters of Cundiff Slough, a tributary of Powder River for the purposes of supplemental irrigation.

This right was perfected under Permit S-20570. The date of priority is June 22, 1951. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.28 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


