## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EMERT RANCHES INC. C/O JOSEPH MCELLIGOTT PO BOX 4 IONE OR 97843

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 20.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73. The date of priority is 1908.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

When required by the Department, the water user shall operate the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The water user shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may monitor the accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in ADDITIONAL POINTS OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 11, 2004, at Special Order Volume 61, Page 181, approving Transfer Application 9454, and together with Certificate 80903, supersedes Certificate 79486, State record of Water Right Certificates.
