confirms the right to use the waters of the FERGUSON CREEK, a tributary of HOOD RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 16.35 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-7399. The date of priority is JUNE 12, 1926. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

2 N	10 E	WM	2	SW NW	1337 FEET SOUTH AND 35 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 2

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate is issued to describe the right NOT modified by provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director, entered JAN 08 2020, and recorded in Special Order Volume 114, Pages 626-635, approving a partial cancellation of the right evidenced by Certificate 74363. This certificate supersedes Certificate 74363.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
