confirms the right to use the waters of ALTHOUSE CREEK, a tributary to the ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 49.8 ACRES, DOMESTIC, AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 209. The date of priority is 1883.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion (SPENCE AND MATHEWSON DITCH).

The water user shall maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain fish screen or fish by-pass devices.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 91390, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 0 5 2020, approving Transfer Application T-12462 and entered approving Transfer Application T-12758.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
