## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-8841. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL WITH IN FORT ROCK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 19.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION DESCRIBED AS BEING WITHIN THE SW ¼ NW ¼, SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.; 820 FEET NORTH AND 100 FEET EAST FROM THE W ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 15)

DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 13, 1980

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

Water use measurement conditions:

- a. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director, at each point of appropriation (new and existing) in good working order.
- b. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Each meter shall be within 50 feet of the well head with a clearly visible monument adjacent to the meter. If placing a meter within 50 feet of the well head is not possible, a surveyed location of the meter site shall be provided to the Department and clearly visible monument adjacent to the meter shall be installed.

The water user shall ensure that the well has been assigned an OWRD Well Identification Number (Well ID tag), which shall be permanently attached to the well. The Well ID shall be used as a reference in any correspondence regarding the well, including any reports of water use, water level, or pump test data.

Dedicated Measuring Tube: Prior to use, all existing wells under this right prior to any possible reconstruction shall be configured to allow a strictly clean water (no oil) static water level measurements with an electric-tape. That can include measurement access via an unobstructed vertical discharge pipe that allows the groundwater level to fluctuate freely within the discharge pipe (no valves, etc.). Otherwise, a dedicated measuring tube must be installed prior to use. The tube must be unobstructed, have a diameter of  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch (0.75 inch) or greater, and pursuant to figure 200-5 in OAR 690-200.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 2, 2015, at Special Order Volume 95, Page 384, approving Transfer Application T-11846, supercedes Certificate 80436, State record of Water Right Certificates.
