confirms the right to use the waters of ONION CREEK, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION under Permit No. S-7292 of the State Engineer, and that said right to use said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; That the priority of the right hereby confirm dates from May 3, 1926 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.225 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND;

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (if for irrigation or any other purpose), is as follows:
