CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE H. & WILLIAM HALL, JR.
PRAIRIE CITY, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1863 – Tract #1.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to Sept. 30; further limited to one acre foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre foot per acre thereafter; total five acre feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 32398, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of the orders of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 02 2020, approving Transfer Application T-12907, and entered JAN 02 2020, approving Transfer Application T-12906.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
