## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

E. N. LIPPERT WATER GAP RD WILLIAMS, OR 97544

confirms the right to use the waters of POWELL CREEK AND LIPPERT RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPL. R-30242, PERMIT R-1845, a tributary of WILLIAMS CREEK for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 15.2 acres and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 5.5 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-24106. The date of priority is MAY 3, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM CREEK AND 11.64 ACRE-FEET – STORED WATER, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit number R-1845 and shall be still further limited to the use of stored water only on lands described as supplemental, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
