CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARTHA MESSINGER & HEIRS OF SIMON MESSINGER, DECEASED PROVOLT, OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of the WILLIAMS CREEK, a tributary of the APPLEGATE RIVER for TRACT 1 and POWELL CREEK, a tributary of WILLIAMS CREEK for TRACT 2; for purposes of IRRIGATION of 15.4 ACRES in TRACT 1 and IRRIGATION of 84.1 ACRES in TRACT 2.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1867.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.257 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND from WILLIAMS CREEK for TRACT 1 and 1.4 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND from POWELL CREEK for TRACT 2 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.
