## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KEN AND MARIA CADE PO BOX 26 FORT ROCK, OR 97326

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 2 (NEW) in the FORT ROCK VALLEY BASIN for IRRIGATION of 41.31 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10701. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 3, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.52 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The water user shall maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device to keep a complete record of the amount ground water withdrawn.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated at the new point of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
