CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STANFIELD HUTTERIAN BRETHREN
36345 DESPAIN GULCH RD
STANFIELD OR 97875

confirms the right to use the waters of COLUMBIA RIVER, tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION of 20.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-32309. The date of priority is AUGUST 15, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.53 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion, located in the SENE of Section 23, Township 5 North, Range 26 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

A description of the place of use to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The water user shall operate and maintain an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion. If the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) determines that the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 91005, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT MODIFIED by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 30, 2018, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-98, and together with Certificates 94862, 94867, and the Applicant's portion of conserved water under CW-98, supersedes Certificate 91005.
