CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVID AND MARIANNE YOST  
65013 KLAGES ROAD  
ENTERPRISE, OR 97828

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH FORK OF WALLOWA RIVER, tributary of WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 12.4 ACRES OF LAND, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Page 203. The date of priority is 1881.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31<sup>st</sup> of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contain in said decree.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Prior to October 1, 2021, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, and a parshall flume, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 24 2020, approving Transfer Application T- 12904, and supersedes Certificate 3188, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
