confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK OF WALLOWA RIVER (LOSTINE RIVER), a tributary of WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 16.6 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Page 181. The date of priority is 1896 FOR TRACT NO. 2.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 11/2 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitation contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Prior to October 1, 2021, the water user shall install and maintain a flume or weir for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
