 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE RANDOLPH BLANKENSHIP
 75 NELSON WAY
 GRANTS PASS, OR 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS a tributary of JUMP-OFF-JOE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 3.28 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5167. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 7, 1972. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.03 CFS FROM WELL NO. 1 AND 0.01 CFS FROM WELL NO. 2 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


