CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the Grande Ronde River, tributary to Snake River for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values; and recreation.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The date of priority is 1869. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.616 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, from March 1 through November 30.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

At the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 90393, located approximately at:

Authorized Point of Diversion:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
2 S	38 E	WM	32	SW SE	640 FEET NORTH AND 190 FEET EAST FROM THE S1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32

The quantity of water diverted at the authorized point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

Original Point of Diversion:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
2 S	38 E	WM	31	SW SW	400 FEET NORTH AND 200 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 31

Water rights upstream of the original point of diversion shall not be subject to regulation for flows in excess of the quantities to which this instream water right is entitled at the original point of diversion.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 90393, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 116, Page 1059, approving Transfer T-13129, and along with Certificate 94692 supersedes Certificate 90393, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
