CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 78.0 ACRES AND POND MAINTENANCE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8683. The date of priority is OCTOBER 18, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.24 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 0.98 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION AND 0.26 CFS FOR POND MAINTENANCE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.


