 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DESCHUTES VALLEY FARMS
 P.O. BOX 166
 CULVER, OR 97734

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE WELLS in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 235.8 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 40.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4396. The date of priority is APRIL 15, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3.45 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.54 CFS FROM WELL 1, 0.74 CFS FROM WELL 2, AND 2.17 CFS FROM WELL 3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
