 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.7 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is 1908.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Prior to October 1, 2021, the water user shall maintain and operate a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.


This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 22 2020, approving Transfer Application T-13123, and supersedes Certificate 94165, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
