CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

VANDEHEY FARMS  
43200 NW GREENVILLE RD  
FOREST GROVE, OR 97116

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK DAIRY CREEK, a tributary of DAIRY CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 30.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-41777. The date of priority is MAY 2, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided that no diversion of water is to be made from July 31 through September 15 of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Direction, another suitable measuring device, in good working order at the point of diversion.


The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and is subject to minimum flows by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate is issued to clarify the point of diversion location, and to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 13, 2018, at Special Order Volume 108, Page 835 approving Transfer T-12840, and together with Certificate 93859, supersedes Certificate 53836, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
