CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W. D. HODGSON,  
HOTEL AUSTIN BLOCK ASHLAND, OREGON AND R. L. MCBRIDE  
MEDFORD, OR 97501

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 94.82 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-807. The date of priority is August 25, 1911. The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.187 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion; Hodgson and McBride Ditch or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

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This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Special Orders entered January 14, 1969 and August 23, 1972 canceled the right to use 0.032 cubic foot per second from the Rogue River for the irrigation of 2.67 acres. This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 48244, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 30 2020, approving Transfer Application T-13224.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
