CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W. H. LEEDS ELLEN H. WAGNER ASHLAND, OR 97520

confirms the right to use the waters of EMIGRANT CREEK, a tributary to BEAR CREEK, for the purposes of IRRIGATION OF 35.45 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 4.55 ACRES; DOMESTIC; STOCK; and DEVELOPMENT of 2 HORSEPOWER.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is DECEMBER 31, 1864.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.55 cfs, being 0.486 cubic foot per second for irrigation of 35.45 acres and .064 cubic foot per second for supplemental irrigation of 4.55 acres, domestic and stock; and 0.25 cubic foot per second for power.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
