## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROSS JAEGER 13488 MCKEE SCHOOL ROAD WOODBURN, OR 97071

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL, in the Willamette Basin for IRRIGATION of 45.5 ACRES, BEING USE OF WATER FROM WELL 5 FOR IRRIGATION OF 45.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10828. The date of priority is February 11, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.51 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation herein.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with an air line and pressure gauge or an access port measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all time. The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

This right is for the beneficial use of water.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

Water shall be acquired from the same basalt aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or groundwater rights.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
