confirms the right to use the waters of WELL #1 and WELL #2 within the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 32.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10222. The date of priority is JANUARY 10, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.41 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or the equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

Water Use Measurement conditions:

- a.) Westland Irrigation District shall monitor the quantity of water diverted from Well #2 authorized under this right which is pumped into the Westland Canal and conveyed down the Canal and re-diverted at Pump 7A.
- b.) The District and water user shall maintain Meter# 95-740-6 located at Well #2 and the totalizing flow meter or, with prior approval of the Director, another measuring device in good working order at (Pump 6E?) where water from Well #2 enters the Westland Canal to be re-diverted down-canal at pump 7A.
- c.) The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The District and water user shall monitor the flow meters to verify that approximately 67% of the water delivered to lands in the NW Quarter of Section 18, T3N, R29E, at meter #08-03539-06 is equal to the amount of water that is pumped into Westland Canal (at Pump 6E?) from Well #2 as measured by the new meter, in as close to real time as possible.

Water from Well #1 may be applied to the 32.6 acres located in the NW Quarter of Section 18, T3N, R29E, only under this right only when surface water is no longer available to serve lands in the NW Quarter under Certificates 76715 and 79439, or their superseding certificates, for irrigation and supplemental irrigation purposes, respectively.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 12, 2012, at Special Order Volume 87, Page 281 approving Transfer T-11328, and together with Certificate 87516, supersedes Certificate 82441, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
