CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOUBLE M RANCH, INC.
31466 ANDREWS ROAD
ECHO, OR 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL #1 within the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 17.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3971. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 1, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.21 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

3 N	28 E	WM	13	NW NE	Well #1 - 270 FEET SOUTH AND 2540 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 13

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or the equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
