CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the DESCHUTES RIVER, tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values, and recreation.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 1, 1899. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed quantities described below during the irrigation season of each year:

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the authorized point of diversion under Certificate 74145, located at approximately River Mile 165:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


gains calculated based on available data and the use of water by senior appropriators will determine the amount of water to which this right is entitled downstream from the original point of diversion within the specified stream reach.

The instream right established by this Allocation of Conserved Water shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470 unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 74145, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 116, Page 502, approving conserved water application CW-106.
