confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-8233. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: WEAVER CREEK, TRIBUTARY TO SOUTH MYRTLE CREEK

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 7.53 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: OCTOBER 31, 1927

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order at each point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for any above purpose is restricted the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a changes in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 16, 2011, at Special Order Volume 83, Page 609, approving Transfer Application 9586, and together with Certificate 86821, supercedes Certificate 8100, State record of Water Right Certificates.
