CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BRIAN THOMPSON 4025 WILLIAMS HWY GRANTS PASS, OR 97527

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED GULCH, a tributary of Snider Creek (Rogue River), for irrigation of 7.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-27208. The date of priority is February 16, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.18 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 ACRE-FEET PER ACRE for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow, provided further that the right to the use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 1000 cfs at Raygold, more than 1000 cfs immediately above the Savage Rapids Dam and more than 735 cfs at its mouth.

The use shall conform to such a reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
