CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-12151. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: THREE WELLS IN MALHEUR LAKE BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 9.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: OCTOBER 16, 1990

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water under this right is limited to that period when necessary for beneficial use in conjunction with the irrigation of their respective lands.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or another suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at each point of appropriation in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation (Well 3 and Well 4), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 31, 2019, at Special Order Volume 114, Page 663, approving Transfer Application T-13048, supersedes Certificate 85800, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
