CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of BURNT RIVER a tributary of THE SNAKE RIVER AND WATER STORED IN UNITY RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-176, for IRRIGATING 1.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50712. The date of priority is AUGUST 5, 1988. This right is limited to 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. DIRECT FLOW FROM THE RIVER IS NOT ALLOWED AFTER JULY 30 OF EACH YEAR.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

12 S	44 E	WM	30	SE NE	2265 FEET SOUTH AND 900 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 30

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 67776, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered ~~OCT 15 2020~~, approving Transfer Application T-13285.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
