 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

E. J. CAMERON
 JACKSONVILLE, OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 2.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1854.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.066 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:


