confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-20943. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: DAIRY CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF TUALATIN RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: AGRICULTURAL (NURSERY) USE ON 21.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE AND VOLUME: 0.27 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND 53.0 ACRE FEET

PERIOD OF USE: MAY 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30 OF EACH YEAR

DATE OF PRIORITY: JANUARY 22, 1952

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in CHARACTER OF USE and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 22, 2012, at Special Order Volume 88, Page 420, approving Transfer Application T-8919, and together with Certificate 81921, supersedes Certificate 23053, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
