confirms the right to store water perfected under the terms of Permit R-1854. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

PURPOSE OR USE: STORAGE FOR MULTIPLE PURPOSES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO PRIMARY AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION AND AGRICULTURAL (NURSERY) USE

MAXIMUM STORAGE VOLUME: 25.0 ACRE-FEET

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to store water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 22, 2012, at Special Order Volume 88, Page 420, approving Transfer Application T-8919, supersedes Certificate 26172, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
