confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-2949. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS A TRIBUTARY OF OAK GROVE SWALE

PURPOSE OR USE: GENERAL USE AT OAK GROVE REST AREA

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.045 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 10, 1965

The wells are located as follows:

This right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (Oak Grove RA Well 2 SB), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Oak Grove RA Well 1 NB), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Oak Grove RA Well 1 NB).

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 7, 2019, at Special Order Volume 114, Page 344, approving Transfer Application T-13077, supersedes Certificate 37944, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
