CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN VAN ZANT C/O M.L. OPDYCKE  
GRANTS PASS, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of the EAST FORK WILLIAMS CREEK, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 27.38 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-2772. The date of priority is December 28, 1915. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.34 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 3353, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **MAY 05 2021** approving Transfer Application T-13483.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
