CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GERALD W. AND MARIE DETERING
HARRISBURG, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO SLOUGHS, which are high water channels of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER for IRRIGATION and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 123.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-22026. The date of priority is JANUARY 12, 1953. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.07 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.535 CFS FROM EACH SLOUGH, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


