CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ESTATE OF GERALD W. DETERING AND MARIE DETERING HARRISBURG, OR 97446

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO. 4, a tributary of AN UNNAMED SLOUGH (WILLAMETTE RIVER) for IRRIGATION of 6.3 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 62.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2636. The date of priority is APRIL 20, 1964. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.86 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.
