CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ZOE A. STEPHENSON
BAKER, OR 97869

confirms the right to use the waters of INDIAN CREEK for the IRRIGATION of 80.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC and STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1877.

The amount of water to which such right is entitle, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to ONE ACRE-FOOT per calendar month to June 1 and FOUR ACRE-FEET per acre during season April 1 to September 30, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 25844 , State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 02 2020, approving Transfer Application T-10898.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
