CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JESPERSEN EDGEWOOD INC.
 12941 SWAN LAKE ROAD
 KLAMATH FALLS, OR 97603

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the SWAN LAKE BASIN for IRRIGATION of 1070.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10952. The date of priority is JUNE 28, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 13.38 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 5.49 CFS FROM WELL 4 AND 7.89 CFS FROM WELL 5 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.


This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 87006, State Record of Water Right Certificate 87006, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 21 2021, approving Transfer Application T-13280.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
